

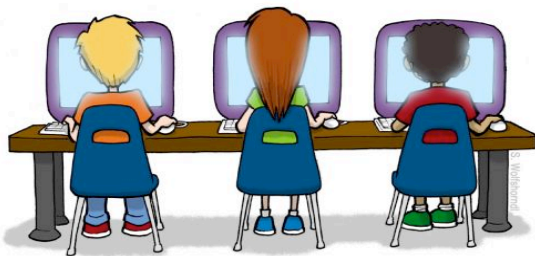

Please help your child do his/her best by doing the following:

- ✓ Be sure your child arrives to school on time
- ✓ Spend a relaxing evening at home the evenings prior to the test
- ✓ Make sure your child gets a good night's sleep
- ✓ Schedule doctor appointments before or after the testing dates
- ✓ Help your child understand that the test shows us all they have learned and remind them that passing to the next grade is not dependent on test results.

Our students in grades 3rd, 4th, 5th & 6th will take the Smarter Balanced Assessments. These new assessments measure critical thinking with questions that ask students to demonstrate their research, writing, and problem solving skills. The tests for both Mathematics and English Language Arts are taken on the computer and are aligned to the Common Core State Standards.
